

Report social dialogue in central government administration

Who

- Central government administrations: 7 million employees in the EU
- ✓ EPSU-led single trade union delegation- TUNED (cooperation agreement with CESI, 2005, revised 2010)- representative in all EU-27+Norway
- ✓ EUPAN- Informal network of EU-27 public administrations DGs- Not an employers organisation
- ✓ Also CEEP: 6 central government representatives – in this context, employers capacity: Denmark, Sweden, Finland, Netherlands, Italy, Austria, and the UK till 2011

Background since last CB conference

- ✓ 2008-2009 Test Phase on formalisation
- ✓ Positive evaluation by TUNED and DGs



- ✓ EU-27 DG for public administration Resolution 10/11.12.09
 - ✓ invite TUNED to continue a "structured informal Social Dialogue"
 - ✓ note option for those employers who want it to go ahead with formalisation
- ✓ TUNED accepts launch social dialogue committee with several member states and continue convincing as many countries as possible to take part
- ✓ TUNED participation in informal SD to be judged against progress with formalisation

Activities in 2010

✓ Spanish and Belgian EU presidencies commit to launching social dialogue committee before end of the year

✓ TUNED/Spanish govt agreement,15.01

- ✓ Taskforce formalisation, 2 meetings
- Bilateral contacts with undecided or opposed employers
- Establishment of an EU employers' organisation, EUPAE
- ✓ Joint TUNED/EUPAE request to the Commission to set up a SSDC, 30.09
- ✓ informal SD meeting on effects of the crisis in central government administrations, meeting 23.11.2010
