The Italian presidency of the EU

Place growth and employment at the centre of European policies. Revitalise the EU 2020 Strategy to focus on employment and poverty reduction, giving impetus to the reform process and allowing the fiscal flexibility necessary to implement productive reforms

Continue efforts to complete the Economic and Monetary Union, building upon the December 2013 report 'Towards a Genuine Economic and Monetary Union'

Promote better use and monitoring of European resources (Structural Funds, EIB, Youth Guarantee, Flagship Initiatives). Proceed with the banking union to deliver on the agreed-upon commitments

ENHANCING INSTITUTIONAL CAPACITY AND ENSURING AN EFFICIENT PA

Modernization of government and enhancing administrative capacity remain a precondition for the success of any action aimed at growth and cohesion, as envisaged in Europe 2020 strategy.

In addition countries still need to take major action for efficiency by reducing and improving the quality of public spending.





Horizontal activities 1/2

1 Future role of PA: open and efficiency oriented

A Innovative and open public administration to build trust and sustain integrity

Qualitative study on how open government policies, (transparency and release of open data, participation, coproduction of services) influenced PA reforms in the last years.





Horizontal activities 2/2

2 Evaluation of the role of the EUPAN network in the 2020 perspective

EUPAN can be the relevant forum where EU countries exchange views on administrative and policy challenges and on solutions to enhance institutional capacity and ensure an efficient PA

An 18 months process of reflection on the future of EUPAN will take place involving the 3 Presidencies of the Trio

<u>**Discussion**</u> on the main areas to focus on will be launched in Rome at the DG meeting

Research activity on strategic competences of civil servants in central PA to map and compare experiences on competency management including its links to mobility

Enhancing institutional and administrative capacity in administrative reforms and the implementation of cohesion policies

1 Enhancing institutional and administrative capacity

<u>Discussion Paper</u>, combining an analytical approach, via preliminary discussion notes with interactive debates during the IPSG meeting, in order to highlight the various perspectives and the different experiences in the MSs.





IPSG activities 2/2

2 The development of quality management systems (QMS): the CAF self assessment for cohesion policies

<u>European study on the use of CAF</u>: focusing on impact on performance results and organizational culture, the case of the Education sector will be analysed together with the collection of opinion leaders and experts' viewpoints on the general use of the model.

6th European CAF Event: to be planned with the contribution of the CAF Network and to be organized by Italy in November in Rome. A new format for the Event will be implemented.

CAF policy brief: as a result of the study and the Event the document will be finalised for discussion during the DG meeting in December in Rome.





Meeting of Ministers

Ministers responsible for Public Administration don't meet at EU level since 2007.

The Italian Presidency of the EU considers highly important to engage on a discussion on PA reform at political level.

A **Ministerial meeting** will be convened in Rome on 3rd December 2014.
